As a self-officiated sport, ultimate relies heavily on our captains to run our leagues. They are the greatest resource we have and we thank you for your time and efforts.

Captain's Responsibilities:

1. Register teams into leagues and invite players online to accept spots to your roster.
2. Fee submission, team payment, and help in collecting individual memberships from your teammates.
3. Must pass the MODS rules quiz (returning captains only) or attend the annual captain's rules clinic.
4. Must attend the Captain's Meeting prior to the start of the season.
5. Promote rules, knowledge, and Spirit of the Game at all times.
6. Be aware of all MODS rules and policies.
7. Act as a liaison between MODS and it's members.
8. Enter game and spirit scores in a timely fashion.
9. Respond to all MODS communications.

In order to register your team, as a captain you must:

1. Register team online.
2. Submit full payment for team fees.
3. Submit two \$100 Performance Bonds (cheques).
4. Have a minimum of 12** registered and paid players on your roster.

** In the winter the requirement is 10 paid players

Responsibilities during the season

As a MODS Captain or Co-Captain, you're expected to:

1. Attend the Captain's meeting (and the Captain's Clinic, unless exempted from attending), or send a co-captain or other designate if unable to attend.
2. Know all the current 11th Edition Rules, and Winnipeg Ultimate League rule amendments.
3. Bring a copy of the 11th Edition Rules and WUL amendments to each game.
4. Promote knowledge of and adherence to the rules among your players.
5. Ensure ALL information and materials given to you by MODS staff are passed on to all your players.
6. Have sufficient players (four minimum) at the field ready to play at the official start time for each game.
7. Ensure that the field is set up for all games.
8. Report the score and spirit rating within a few days of a game.
9. Notify the opposing team at least 24 hours in advance if you're unable to field a team for a scheduled game. Note teams will lose one performance bond for a cancelation with notice and both bonds for a cancelation without 24 hours notice.

12. Stop play or postpone a game in order to safeguard a field against damage. If a field is too wet to play on, postpone the game.
13. Demonstrate, encourage, and promote Spirit of the Game at all times.
